ESSAY Guidelines: Your essay must be legible and preferably typed on separate sheets of paper and attached. For any scholarship essay, provide some autobiographical information in narrative form that tells something about the kind of person you are. **Do not include any identifying biographical information** such as your name and address or your parent's name and address, etc. **These are to be an original statements, unedited by counselors, teachers or parents. Please limit each essay response to 250 words or less.**

- 1) Reflect on a specific community service project or initiative you have led or participated in that directly impacted the lives of veterans. How did this experience shape your understanding of patriotism and service to those who have served our country?
- 2) Discuss a significant event or moment in your life that instilled in you a deep sense of appreciation for the sacrifices made by veterans. How has this appreciation influenced your commitment to serving your community or engaging in activities that honor their service?
- 3) In your opinion, what role should schools and educational institutions play in educating young people about the sacrifices and contributions of veterans? Share ideas or experiences you have had in advocating for increased awareness of veterans' issues within your school or community.

- 4) Explain your personal connection to a member of American Legion Post 677 and how this relationship has influenced your perspective on both community involvement and the role of the military.
